Date

Saturday 20th & Sunday 21st May 2023

Venue

Wigan Life Centre, College Avenue, Wigan, WN1 1NJ

Facilities

8 Lane (2 ½ m wide) 25m Pool using Colorado System 6 Electronic Timing and uses anti wave lane ropes. Spectator balcony for with seating for 250, with an additional comfort area overlooking the pool.

Age

As at 21st May 2023

Entries

Entries are open to club swimmers aged 9 to 16 years old, on a first come, first served basis. Entries must include a time, official/ranked times are not needed, coach's times are fine, all times must not exceed the upper limit, entries without a time will be rejected. Entries will be seeded on a slowest to fastest basis. No late or poolside entries will be accepted. All entries are to be completed individually online only, to enter online your club must first be registered.

Entry Fee

£6.00 per event and must be paid at the time of submission, entries are not valid until payment has been completed.

Club Registration

Before an entry can be submitted the club must confirm their attendance via email to starter@wiganswimming.co.uk, the club will then be added to the online entry system.

Rejections

Will only be made if an entry does not meet the conditions or in the case of meet is over subscribed, refunds will be issued for those events affected only.

Accepted Entries

Accepted entries will be posted on the entry website before the meet. No further information will be returned.

Opening Date

Wednesday 22nd March 2023 or once your club has been registered.

Closing Date

Wednesday 3rd May 2023 or when the meet is full

Awards

Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, whose times are below the upper limit and will be awarded in the following age groups; 9 years, 10 years, 11 years, 12 years, 13 years and 14 years & over. Those whose times exceed the upper times at the meet will not be awarded with a medal but will be able to collect a ticket.

The top club trophy is awarded to the club scoring the highest points from the meet. The fastest eight swimmers to score in each age group/event.

Age Groups

9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 & over.

Racing

The competition will be held under Swim England Law and FINA technical rules.

One start rule will apply. Over the top starts may be used at the organiser's discretion.

Results

All results will be posted on the competitions website.

Withdrawals

Withdrawals are accepted up to 45 minutes before the session is due to start, via electronic submission, on the competition's website, passphrase is 'pies'. Refunds will not be processed for withdrawals.

Withdrawal due to exception circumstances

Individuals who have withdrawn from events due to either a medical reason or injury, a refund will be considered by application and submission of appropriate evidence from registered professional (HCPC, etc) or recognized medical/health institution (NHS, Bupa, ect).

Withdrawing from the event must be completed prior to the event/session in which the individual is due to compete, in the normal way. Any failure to withdraw or notification of withdrawal received later than the event withdrawal cut off time will result in no refund being processed. Please submit application details within 5 days of the meet ending. Once the refund has been processed, documents relating to an individual's medical information will be destroyed.
